PREPARATORY CLASSES

This preparatory course of one or two semesters is conceived for students with no prior studies in the field of art and does not require knowledge in French language. This program includes a FLE courses (French as a Foreign Language), with a focus on art oriented texts and vocabulary, beginner's courses in artistic culture and techniques (drawing, plastic arts, graphic design software, interior design, etc), and cultural visits. 

CREATE A PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

All programs at Autograf give you the opportunity to have a professional experience through internship.

Each student will complete from 4 weeks to several months of internship depending on the programs. This compulsory internship gives the student the opportunity to be in contact with professional reality, and it facilitates their future integration into working life.

At Autograf we believe that a professional experience is a true tool for each student, allowing them to practice their knowledge in a real work environment, but also being part of projects that will add content to their portfolio and resume for their future career.

Students will also have the possibility to choose work-study courses. Which will allow students to study and work at the same time. They will spend one week in school every 2 or 3 weeks and the rest of the time will be spent working for the company that hired them.

It has real benefits, such as a professional experience to add to your resume, reduction of tuition fees and payment of a salary. To be able to do work-study courses, international students must have completed some criteria to be able to sign a contract, but this is accessible to them in particular from their second year of study.

Thanks to its partnership with the Japanese school Osaka SOGO Design, Autograf offers to its students, in addition to its International Bachelor of French-Japanese Design, a Bachelor of Video Games with a Japanese flavor.

Additional educational courses and programs oriented towards Japanese culture and arts are integrated to the classic curriculum of the Bachelor's degree in Video Games Art. Thus, Japanese language courses (optional), Japanese artistic culture courses and Japanese drawing classes supplement the program.

Twice a year, international workshops are organized with our partner school in Japan. One takes place in Paris and the other in Osaka. Also, throughout the year, conferences given by Japanese designers and professors are organized, as well as joint French-Japanese projects.
